



A Special Message to Our Seniors

Great News!

As you may have heard, the Senior Center will be remodeled as part of the Senior Center Modernization Project. Construction will take place from February 3 through November 3, 2025. During this time, Senior Center meals and activities will continue but will be relocated to the Community Center. Program details are provided below.



Will the Senior Center close during construction?

Yes, but meals and activities will be relocated to the Community Center and former library space at Town Hall and continue as usual. FSA will continue to cook in the kitchen.



Will Senior Center programs continue during construction?

Yes! After a short break to move operations to the Community Center, lunch and activities will continue as usual.



What improvements will be made to the Senior Center?

Full remodel of restrooms to ADA standards	Lobby remodel/modernization
New automatic doors	Reception desk remodel
New classroom for senior programs	Updated lighting & HVAC system
Modern office spaces	New ADA sidewalks/crosswalk
Exterior paint/landscaping	Installation of fiber for internet



When will this happen?

February 3-17 is a Two-Week Closure to Move Operations

The Center will close to relocate operations, so no lunch service or programs on these dates. However, FSA hot lunch will be available at the Joshua Tree Community Center or seniors can preregister for frozen meals (pick-up on February 3 and 10 from 9-10 am at the Community Center).

February 18: Reopening Day

Lunch and programs will restart at the Community Center locations noted below.



Where will lunch and my favorite programs take place?

Most activities will move to Town Hall building (former library space across the parking lot), including:
