Thank you for your interest in working with the Town of Yucca Valley Animal Care and Control. We hope to collaborate with rescue groups to place as many of our companion animals as we can into loving homes. It is only through collaboration and mutual aid that we can eliminate the need to euthanize adoptable animals for lack of homes.

Please note: A kennel license / permit may be required if you will be housing animals over the maximum number allowed for your neighborhood. You should verify the requirements for your area with the proper agency, before completing the attached application.

ANIMAL RESCUE GROUP ADOPTION AGREEMENT

State of California Food and Agriculture Code Sections 31108(b) and 31752(b) authorizes the Town to release any stray dog or cat that is impounded, prior to being euthanized, to a nonprofit corporation, as defined in section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, animal rescue group and,

State of California Food and Agriculture Code Sections 30503(c) and 31751.3(c) authorizes the Town to enter into cooperative agreements with animal rescue groups in lieu of requiring spay and neuter deposits and,

The Town wants to reduce the number of animals euthanized and recognizes the value of animal rescue groups to help place companion animals into new homes.

Therefore, in cooperation, the undersigned animal rescue group agrees as follows:

1. All dogs and/or cats adopted from Town of Yucca Valley Animal Care and Control under this agreement will be utilized only for placement as companion animals.
2. All dogs and/or cats adopted under this agreement will be spayed or neutered before being placed into a new home. Proof of said spaying or neutering must be provided to the Town of Yucca Valley Animal Shelter upon placement of the dog or cat.
CA Food and Agriculture Code 30503 / 31751.3
3. All dogs and/or cats adopted under this agreement will be microchipped before being placed into a new home. Proof of said microchipping must be provided to the Town of Yucca Valley Animal Shelter upon placement of the dog or cat.
CA Food and Agriculture Code 31108.3 / 31752.1
4. All dogs over the age of four (4) months adopted under this agreement that will reside within the jurisdiction of the Town of Yucca Valley must be licensed. New owners are to be advised by the rescue group of licensing requirements. The rescue group must provide to the Town of Yucca Valley Animal Care and Control proof of rabies vaccination and address of the new owners upon placement of said dogs, but not longer than 30 days from the initial adoption.
5. The rescue group will provide a list of personnel along with their driver's license numbers that are authorized to adopt under this agreement and will provide a complete list of addresses where the animals will be housed until placed.

6. Each address where animals are housed prior to placement must remain in compliance with all applicable laws, ordinances and requirements regarding proper housing, care and the maximum number of animals allowed.
7. Town of Yucca Valley Animal Care and Control reserves the right to determine which animals and the number of animals that will be eligible for adoption under this agreement.
8. This agreement may be revoked or modified by Yucca Valley Animal Care and Control without prior notice.
9. The rescue group accepts full and unconditional responsibility to ensure full compliance with this agreement by its staff and volunteers and accepts full and unconditional responsibility for the proper care and control of the animals released to it for adoption.
